Note: (C) means a grade of "C", in the "C" range (C+, C, C-) or better is required.

Important Components of CATS:

- Students must meet certain minimum requirements, or "critical tracking criteria", within the recommended paths, to demonstrate minimal progress toward degree completion.
 - Critical tracking criteria may include critical courses, minimum GPA requirements, or both.
 - Critical courses appear **in bold** on the recommended paths.
- Students are tracked only during *fall* and *spring* semesters, for the first 5 semesters. Summer terms and intersessions may be used to "catch up" and get back on track.

Minimal Tracking Assessments:

- Students are not making minimal progress if they fail to meet one or more critical tracking criteria. The University notifies students via their myLSU email accounts, if they fail to make minimal progress. Students are advised to see a counselor in their college to resolve any issues.
