PI salary & fringe benefits (50% academic year + 50% summer)	<i>Requested Funds</i> No F&A allowed
Student and support personnel	
Travel	<i>Matching Funds*</i>
Supplies	48% of MTDC for Research
Equipment	49% for MTDC for Instruction
Publication costs	35% for MTDC for Public Service
Other expenses	

*MTDC = Modified Total Direct Costs

Additional Budgetary Guidelines:

The submitting department and/or college is required to match on a 1:1 basis any request for salary support from the ATLAS program.

PI must use the Excel budget spreadsheets provided at [LSU's OSP website](#). These spreadsheets contain additional budget information and will automatically calculate fringe benefits, indirect costs and the composite budget page.

Note:

If Graduate Assistant (GA) tuition remission is budgeted as institutional match, the GA must be appointed and charged as proposed in order to ensure the tuition remission match is met.
